Dear Mr. Davis:

Please find attached a copy of my letter ("1st Response") which was responsive to your demand letter ("14 Apr Letter") (copy attached) wherein you were ordering me to cease and desist my non-commercial usage of my lawfully registered domain name "www.kipmckean.com" and demanding my assignment of this domain name to the City of Angels International Christian Church ("COA Church") within 45 days of receipt of your 14 Apr Letter, which is on or about 10 June, 2010, or you "will commence litigation in this matter." My 1st Response was delivered and a notice left on 3 May, 2010 via Certified Mail, return receipt, to the California address you indicated on your 14 Apr Letter, but has yet to be retrieved from the post office.

Unfortunately, as of this letter ("2nd Response"), you have not replied to me. I did discover that you are listed among the attorneys at Vancouver Defenders, in Washington state, and hence am sending this letter to your firm's address to try to reach you.

I cannot find your name among the attorneys licensed in good standing with the California State Bar Association, although in your 14 Apr Letter you present yourself as an "attorney at law" with a return address in California.

As you know, a lawyer shall not practice law in a jurisdiction in violation of the regulation of the legal profession in that jurisdiction, or assist another in doing so. In California: *"Any person advertising or holding himself or herself out as practicing or entitled to practice law or otherwise practicing law who is not an active member of the State Bar... is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by to one year in a county jail or by a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or by both that fine and imprisonment."*

As I stated in my 1st Response, given the prevalence of fraud associated with UPL demands on unsuspecting persons, given that you fail to indicate to what capacity, if any, you represent the COAICC and/or Mr. Thomas McKean, given you fail to indicate any bar licensing in CA or any other state in your 14 Apr Letter, given you cite a seemingly inappropriate legal basis of your claim, etc., and given you've ignored my 1st Response, as promised I am referring what seems to me to be your unprofessional and suspicious conduct to the Washington State Bar Association for their investigation.
